

Physics and Astronomy Prize Summer Research Fellowship

This fellowship will be awarded to an outstanding first-year physics student. The prize recipient will be paid to work with the research group led by a P&A faculty member for 12 weeks in summer 2017.

Requirements:

Applicants must have successfully completed Physics 1301/1401/1501 and be in good standing in Physics 1302/1402/1502 or WISc 1001X Physics at the time of their application.

Applicants must submit an academic Letter of Recommendation, and a brief (one-page) personal statement on their long-term goals and their interests in doing a research project in Physics or Astronomy. They should indicate the faculty member and project they are interested in from the list of projects posted on our website. Students must contact potential supervisors before submitting an application. **Any student who applies for the internship will automatically be considered for other paid summer research projects in the department.** Students who have been awarded an NSERC USRA are not eligible for this award. *Deadline:* Friday, March 10, 2017
